## >> what else? Calvert 22

WITH so much Brit art being snapped up by rich Russians, it's refreshing to see a gallery fostering a bit of cultural exchange. Calvert 22, which opens tomorrow, is dedicated to exhibiting modern Russian and Eastern European art.

The opening show features five contemporary Russian artists united by the theme of examining the past

to look to the future. They include Haim Sokol, who makes his art from tools and detritus bartered from migrant workers, and Leonid Tishkov, whose work includes knitted internal organ-esque objects – probably explained by his previous career as a gastroenterologist.
